Dear Mr. Speaker Harrell and Mr. President McConnell:

This refers to Act No. 75 (H. 3992) (2011), which provides for the 2011 redistricting of South Carolina's congressional districts, submitted to the Attorney General pursuant to Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C. 1973c. We received your submission on August 31, 2011; additional information was received through October 26, 2011.

The Attorney General does not interpose any objection to the specified change. However, we note that Section 5 expressly provides that the failure of the Attorney General to object does not bar subsequent litigation to enjoin the enforcement of the change. Procedures for the Administration of Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 28 C.F.R. 51.41.
